To declare the major, you must complete this form (W208) with your prospective Economics advisor. Your prospective advisor will sign the W208 AND the major declaration form. You will provide both forms to the Registrar. Give one of the W208 forms to the Winthrop 208 office. Keep one copy for your own records. You may also fill out a virtual copy of the form, get your adviser's signature over email, and submit copies via email.

When reviewing with your advisor, you must *provide a copy of your transcript or ACCESS DEGREEWORKS* to show that **you have received grades of B- in ECO 111 and ECO 112 (or at least A- in one of them)** or have passed the qualifying exam. <u>Note in GRADE section below</u>.

- 1. Core courses must be completed by the <u>end of the junior year</u>; students who have not done so will not be permitted to continue in the major. **If you are planning to study abroad in the spring of your junior year, you must complete these requirements PRIOR to going abroad. Plan carefully or you may have to choose between going abroad and majoring in Economics.
- 2. Students may substitute an AP or IB or A-level course for ECO 111 and/or ECO 112. The course substitution(s) will then count toward the 10 courses required to complete the economics major. The minimum grade to substitute for ECO 111/ECO 112 is an AP score of 4 or 5, an IB score of 6 or 7, or an A-level score of A* or A. The <u>prerequisites</u> for ECO 230 (STA 107 or AP Statistics) do <u>not</u> count towards the required ten courses for the major.
- 3. With the exception of AP, IB, and A-level courses being used to place out of ECO 111 or ECO 112, no more than two (2) courses may be taken outside the College to apply toward the major. These courses will be counted as 200-level elective courses.
